

COMMUNITY MURAL



Volunteers from the Conservation Corps North Bay and the Marinwood community paint a large scenic mural on the north face of a vacant storefront at the Marinwood Plaza shopping center on Friday to help beautify the area that now hosts a weekly farmers market. Paint and other supplies were donated by the conservation corps, the community and a local paint store, said Ron Gradinger, a director of the Marinwood Community Farmers Market. The mural stretches across five panels, each 8 to 10 feet long, Gradinger said. The farmers market, at Marinwood Avenue and Miller Creek Road, runs from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturdays.
